Did You Know?

Volunteers - who have the ideas and carry them through the planning process as well as helping to clean up and put the chairs and tables away. Architectural Review Committee (ARC): If you are planning to remodel your condo, please remember many things need to be approved in advance. Windows, lanai railings, doors, exterior

paint change, to name a few. Flooring, especially on the 2nd floor, needs to meet codes. If your project includes outdoor painting, your neighbors must all agree, and the color must be approved- YES there's more than 1 Timbercreek brown and white on file so check with us before you get too far into the job. It's important that improvements made end up in vour file. Also, keep in mind that construction debris, such as old floor coverings, shower doors, tile, trim, cabinets, cardboard boxes, toilets, etc., should NOT be disposed of in condo dumpsters. Your contractor should haul this off site. If you have questions regarding vour anv planned improvements, give any one of us a call and we will get the answer for you along with the Architectural Review form that should be submitted before work Thanks, your Architectural Review begins. Seasonal Maintenance: Jackie Marti recently had an incident in her condo that caused flooding

in the transom cavity under the AC unit. She was very lucky that Ed noticed it when he was checking her unit. Just a word to the wise of how important it is to have your AC maintained seasonally (preferably twice a year) to make sure the AC drain stays free of clogs. The buildings at Timber Creek that have

multiple floors share the same AC drain line and multiple units could be damaged from neighbors from above or below if this line gets clogged. There are moisture detecting devices found on Amazon that could be used for this issue, even wi-fi enabled.
