Community Garden Plots Available:

Garden plots are now available at the Kirkwood Presbyterian church garden area - the area inside the white fence as one drives out of Timber Creek.

The plots are ready for you, an experienced gardener with a green thumb or a wannabe - they are 4 X 8 feet and some have raised beds ready for planting. Other plots are for Earth Box gardening - Earth Boxes need less attention because they have water reservoirs in the bottom that typically only need to be filled once a week through the tube that extends to the top.



For all plots, the soil, water, sunshine, and good graces are provided by the church for \$20 per year per plot. It is a great deal if you want fresh, wholesome, healthy vegetables of your choice and/or flowers only a short walk away from TC. The timing of planting in area 9B is good for full time and

snowbird residents given the abundance of Florida sunshine and reasonable temperatures from fall to spring.


