

Did You Know?

Both large remodeling projects like replacing windows and railings etc., as well as "touch up" jobs like changing storm doors or painting front doors need prior ARC approval.

This may help you choose the correct approved colors:

- Timber Creek Brown- 420 Ultra Velvet Timber Creek Brown
- Beige 420 Ultra Velvet White #X-018
- White (Stucco) 420 Ultra Velvet White Body
- Deep Teal 435 All Grip S/G Tint Semi-Gloss #X-054

All paint can be found at Florida Paint on Cortez Road. Do not change the color without ARC approval and having neighbors in agreement.

There is also a breakdown of Owner responsibility and Association responsibility as it relates to each individual condo. This applies to electrical, plumbing, drywall, and lanai roofing, to name a few. Your ARC is familiar with this and can help you. Architectural Review Request Forms can be found on Town Square. They can be sent directly to the ARC chairperson or dropped off in the office and Dawn will direct them to the ARC chairperson. It may seem like a hassle but it's a necessary step that really can save you additional headaches.
